Transitioning Guide:

(7-10 Days)

Transition slowly from kibble using this guide to avoid tummy troubles.

Day 1-3: 75% current kibble + 25% Chef K9

Day 4-6: 50% kibble + 50% Chef K9

Day 7-9: 25% kibble + 75% Chef K9

Day 10+: 100% Chef K9

Portion Guidelines:

Portions vary based on weight, activity level, and breed. Adjust portions as needed to maintain a healthy weight.

Small Dogs (10-20 lbs): 1½ – 2½ cups per day

Medium Dogs (21-50 lbs): 2½ – 4 cups per day

Large Dogs (51-80 lbs): 4 – 5½ cups per day

Giant Breeds (81+ lbs): 5½ – 7 cups per day

These guidelines are intentionally generous. Please adjust portions based on your dog's individual needs.



Feeding Tips:

Start Slow

Transition over 5-7 days, especially when switching from kibble.

Fresh Food Is More Filling

Fresh food meals are more nutrient-dense than kibble. Many dogs thrive on less food than expected once fully transitioned.

Split Daily Meals

For best digestion, divide daily portions into two meals. Puppies and very active dogs may benefit from two smaller meals.

Cold Or Warm

Most dogs enjoy Chef K9 meals cold straight from the refrigerator, but if your pup prefers warm food, you can serve it slightly warmed (not hot) to enhance flavor and aroma.

Open & Serve Tips:

Here are two easy ways to open and serve:

Option 1: Pour & Store

- Thaw pouch in the refrigerator
- Open the bag & pour the entire bag into a storage container
- Store the container in the refrigerator
- Scoop out portions as needed at feeding time

Option 2: Cut & Squeeze

- Thaw pouch in the refrigerator
- Cut a small corner off the bag
- Squeeze food directly into your dog's bowl
- Fold the bag down, secure with bag clip, store in the refrigerator
- Refrigerate after opening. Use within 5-7 days.



Dog Treats Guidelines:

- Store treats in the refrigerator. Treats should be used within 14 days. After this time, they should be discarded
- Always supervise your dog while enjoying treats. Break into smaller pieces for small dogs if needed.
- A light white powder may appear on the surface of treats. This is a natural result of our baking and cooling process and is completely normal.
- Chef K9 treats are intended for supplemental feeding only. Offer in moderation as a reward or training treat and adjust meals as needed.
